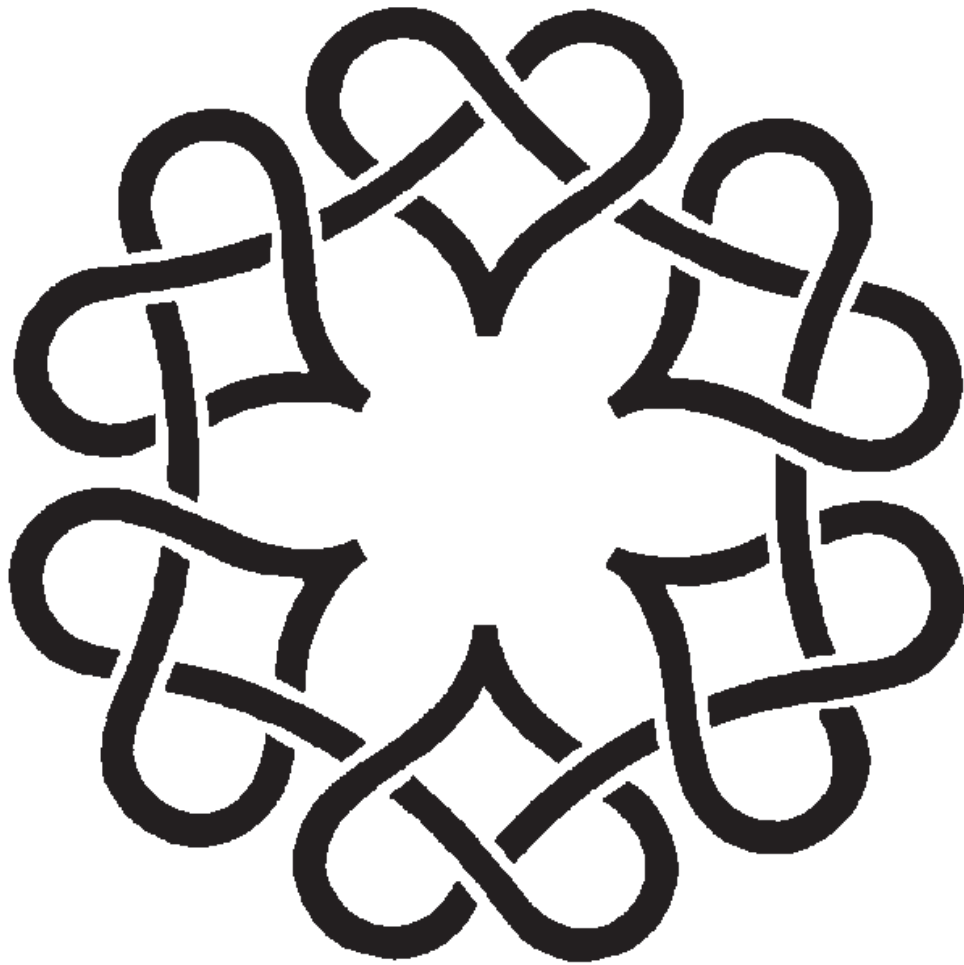

What is

Camp Koinonia?

"Koinonia" is a Greek word meaning fellowship. Camp Koinonia was established by the Belton Church of Christ in August 1975 as a special opportunity for young men and women to grow in Christian fellowship with each other and with God. Under the oversight of the Belton Church of Christ elders and staffed by faithful members of Churches of Christ, Camp Koinonia offers young people positive spiritual guidance in an age of deception, doubt, and hopelessness.

The whole camping experience is designed to meet two goals. First, the Gospel of Jesus is delivered in a very special and powerful way for young people. Second, great attention is given to see that every camper experiences what our name represents which is being part of a true Christian fellowship, koinonia.

Tell me more about the cost of Camp Koinonia?

Camper fee of \$140 covers (1) food and lodging from arrival through departure, (2) all crafts, (3) snacks, (4) a camp notebook with all curriculum and materials, and (5) a camp T-shirt.

A \$25 deposit is required with the application. The remainder of the fee is due on or before June 11. Campers not paid in full by this date are subject to losing their reservation and deposit to those on the waiting list.

What makes my experience at Camp Koinonia so special?

"It's GREAT!" That's what we want to hear each camper say about their whole camping experience, BUT we accomplish this in very special and unique ways. First, we want you to find the JOY of meeting Jesus. At camp every year numerous young people put on Christ in baptism and many others recommit their lives to Him. Second, we want you to find JOY in forming Christian friendships. Campers find they make friends at camp which can last for a lifetime.

One other very special thing that Camp Koinonia offers is real hands-on experiences as a student leader. Not only does the camp experience minister to you, but there are a multitude of ways to minister to others as well.

How do I sign up For Camp Koinonia?

Fill out the Camper Application (on the opposite page), including two sets of camper and parent/guardian signatures, and send it along with your \$25 nonrefundable / nontransferable deposit to: Camp Koinonia, c/o Belton Church of Christ, 3003 N. Main, Belton, TX. 76513, Attention: Camper Applications Processing.

We will begin accepting applications on March 24. While we have two weeks of camp, (Sr. Week and Jr. Week), last year both camps were nearly FULL. Space is

limited and applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

WHO can attend Camp Koinonia?

Boys and girls who are going into the fifth grade through 2008 high school graduates are eligible. All students, regardless of religious affiliation, are welcome.

WHEN is Camp Koinonia?

June 22-27 is Senior Camp for those entering the ninth grade and up. June 28-July 3 is Junior Camp for those entering the fifth through eighth grades.

WHERE is Camp Koinonia?

We use the facilities of Hensel Youth Camp, located about 30 miles west of IH-35 just off FM-1431 headed towards Marble Falls.

WHAT IS THE COST of Camp Koinonia?

Camp Koinonia is one of the greatest values in Christian Camping at only \$140 for the entire week.

Camp photo albums and DVD's will be \$10 each. Mark your selection on your registration form and include your payment with your form. Orders may also be placed at registration. Payment is due at that time.

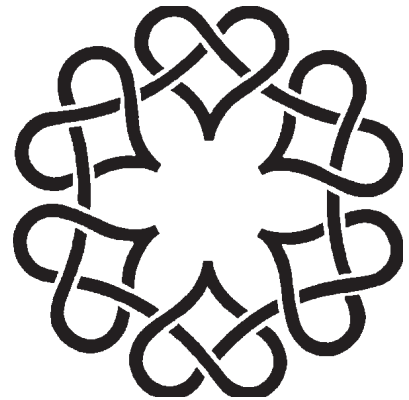

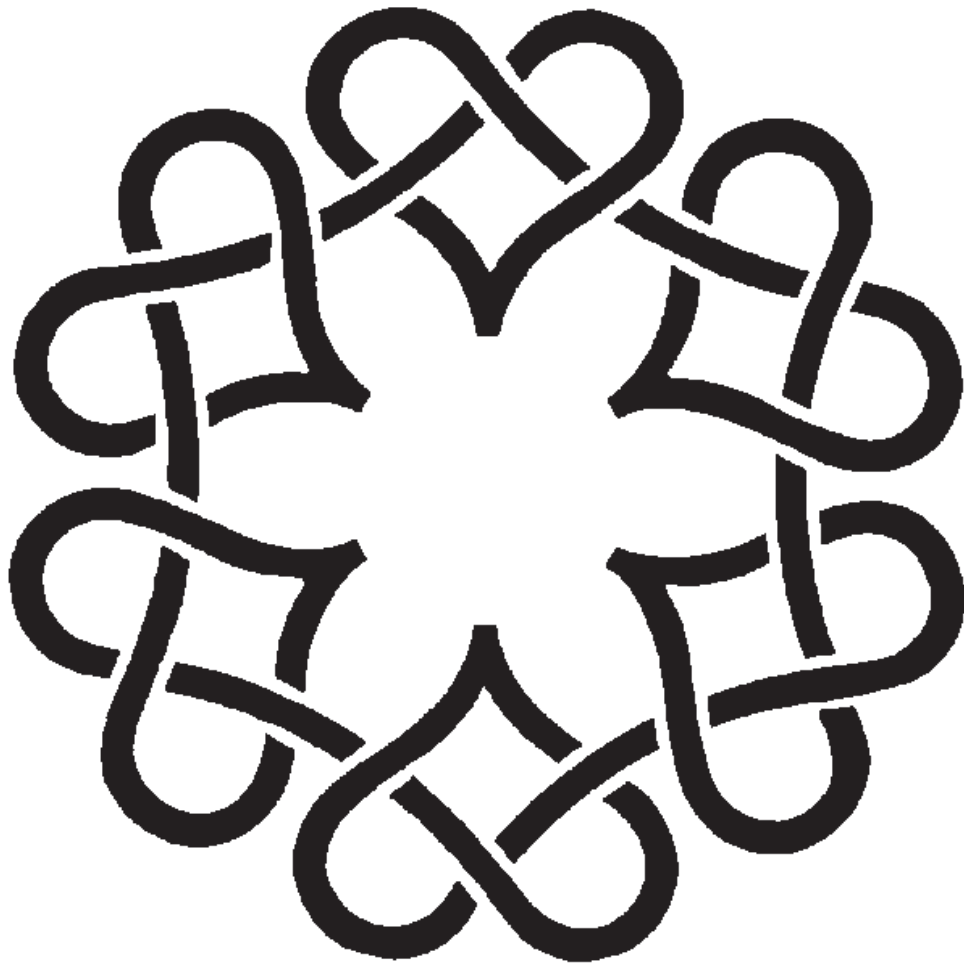
